KIA COVID-19 VACCINATION DRAW

Arviat

(April 20, 2022, Rankin Inlet, Nunavut) The Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) Encouraging Inuit to get their COVID-19 vaccinations. Kivalliq Inuit who are fully vaccinated will be eligible to win 1 ATV or 1 Snowmobiles in each of the seven Kivalliq Communities. The draw will be held on Monday, May 2nd, 2022.

Baker Lake

Kivalliq Inuit, enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement, over the age of five will be automatically entered into the draw. Individuals who have their names drawn will need to show proof of vaccination by May 6, 2022. Adults and children who have received Moderna or Pfizer will need to show proof of two doses and adults who received Johnson & Johnson's vaccine will need to show proof of one dose.

Chesterfield Inlet

There will be one snowmobile and one ATV drawn per Kivalliq community and the Inuit will be eligible to win only in their home community. The winners must be a permanent and living-in resident of any of the 7 Kivalliq Communities. Students who are away for school are considered permanent residents of their home communities in the Kivalliq Region and are eligible for the draw. Those individuals who primarily live outside the Kivalliq Region such as in the Baffin or Kitikmeot Regions or living in the south, or anywhere elsewhere outside the Kivalliq Region are not eligible to win these draws.

Coral Harbour

Each snowmobile and ATV are already located in the Kivalliq community (With the exception of Whale Cove, where the Snowmobile or ATV will be shipped to the drawn individuals).

Nauyasat

There will be only one ATV and one Snowmobile drawn per Kivalliq community. The first winner of the draw for each community will select the vehicle of choice. An ATV or Snowmobile. Then the second winner of that community will receive the other vehicle.
