Rankin Inlet, Nunavut, March 27, 2024 – The Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) is pleased to announce the upcoming Fuel Voucher Distribution Plan for the Kivalliq Region. The KIA Board of Directors approved the Fuel Voucher Program for Kivalliq beneficiaries in COVID-19 funding. This program will provide a one-time \$200.00 fuel voucher to each beneficiary residing in the Kivalliq Region, enrolled in the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement and who is 16 years of age & over.

Distribution of the fuel vouchers will commence on March 28, 2024 from 9:30am to 5:00pm CST and will continue on April 2, 2024 from 9:00am to 5:00pm CST.

Below are the locations for the distribution in each community:

- Arviat – Katimavik Suites
- Baker Lake – Community Hall
- Chesterfield Inlet – Cultural Centre
- Coral Harbour – Hamlet Chambers
- Nauyaat – Hamlet Chambers
- Rankin Inlet – Singiituuq Complex (Old Arena)
- Whale Cove – Wellness Centre

Individuals will be required to provide their NTI Enrolment Card for verification purposes. As this is a one-time distribution program, once each community has distributed its full allotment of vouchers, no more vouchers will be provided. **No replacement vouchers will be issued due to loss or damages.** The vouchers have no cash value, no cash back, the full amount of each voucher **must** be used, any unused balances WILL NOT be credited or put on a gift card for future purchases. Students attending post secondary, outside of their home community may designate their voucher to be picked up by a family member, or can be picked up upon completion of their studies. The vouchers can only be used for gas, naphtha or home heating fuel. The vouchers must be used no later than August 31, 2024.
